Title: **INTERNSHIP
(PRACTICAL TRAINING)**

Aim: Practical Training (PT) is a statutory and mandatory internship course in the Curriculum of the School of Chemical Engineering of NTUA since 1990. PT takes place at the end of the 8th semester and has duration of one month. Since 2009, around 1450 undergraduate students of the School have fulfilled the PT requirements and were placed in more than 500 host organizations in Greece and abroad.

Content: PT takes place in both private and public host organizations, regarding various areas of chemical engineering such as: Petroleum–Natural Gas, Chemical Products–Paints–Plastics, Inorganic Materials–Metallurgy, Pharmaceutical–Cosmetics, Food–Beverages, Research Centers, Consulting–Technical Companies, Public Institutions–Social and Charitable Organizations–Regional Authorities.
